## **Crucified Living: Productive or Blind?**

<u>2 Peter 1:8-12</u> - For if you possess these qualities and continue to grow in them, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> But whoever lacks these traits is nearsighted to the point of blindness, having forgotten that he has been cleansed from his past sins.

10 THEREFORE, brothers, strive to make your calling and election sure. For if you practice these things you will never stumble, <sup>11</sup> and you will receive a lavish reception into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. <sup>12</sup> Therefore I will always remind you of these things, even though you know them and are established in the truth you now have.

## By Not Displaying Godly Characteristics

<u>Matthew 13:22</u> - The seed that fell among the thorns represents those who hear God's word, but all too quickly the message is crowded out by the worries of this life and the lure of wealth, so no fruit is produced.

John 15:5-8 - "Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. <sup>6</sup> Anyone who does not remain in me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned. <sup>7</sup> But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! <sup>8</sup> When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father.
