1 John 2:6 - Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did.

<u>Philippians 4:9</u> - Keep <u>putting into practice all you learned and received from me</u>—<u>everything you heard</u> <u>from me and saw me doing</u>. Then the God of peace will be with you.

<u>Luke 6:38</u> - Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down, shaken together <u>to</u> <u>make room for more</u>, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back."

Proverbs 11:24 - Give freely and become more wealthy; be stingy and lose everything.

We're To Give Generously, Promptly, And Running Over.

Acts 9:36-42 - There was a believer in Joppa named Tabitha (which in Greek is Dorcas). She was always doing kind things for others and helping the poor. 37 About this time she became ill and died. Her body was washed for burial and laid in an upstairs room. 38 But the believers had heard that Peter was nearby at Lydda, so they sent two men to beg him, "Please come as soon as possible!" 39 So Peter returned with them; and as soon as he arrived, they took him to the upstairs room. The room was filled with widows who were weeping and showing him the coats and other clothes Dorcas had made for them. 40 But Peter asked them all to leave the room; then he knelt and prayed. Turning to the body he said, "Get up, Tabitha." And she opened her eyes! When she saw Peter, she sat up! 41 He gave her his hand and helped her up. Then he called in the widows and all the believers, and he presented her to them alive. 42 The news spread through the whole town, and many believed in the Lord.

Proverbs 19:17 - If you help the poor, you are lending to the LORD— and he will repay you!

<u>Hebrews 13:16</u> - And don't forget to do good and to share with those in need. These are the sacrifices that please God.

<u>Philippians 4:18</u> - At the moment I have all I need—and more! I am generously supplied with the gifts you sent me with Epaphroditus. <u>They are a sweet-smelling sacrifice that is acceptable and pleasing to God</u>.

<u>James 1:27</u> - Pure and genuine religion in the sight of God the Father means <u>caring for orphans and widows in</u> <u>their distress</u> and <u>refusing to let the world corrupt you</u>.

Outward Rituals Can't Replace Outward Righteousness, Church Attendance Can't Replace Serving Others.

<u>Deuteronomy 15:10-11</u> - Give generously to the poor, not grudgingly, for the LORD your God will bless you in everything you do. 11 There will always be some in the land who are poor. That is why I am commanding you to share freely with the poor and with other Israelites in need.
