<u>Galatians 5:13-15</u> - For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love. <sup>14</sup> For the whole law can be summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." <sup>15</sup> But if you are always biting and devouring one another, watch out! Beware of destroying one another.

**Exchange Self-Indulgence With Loving Service To Others** 

<u>Galatians 5:16-18</u> - So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. <sup>17</sup> The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions. <sup>18</sup> But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.

The Spirit And The Flesh Are At War With Each Other; They Have Different Appetites Which Creates Conflict.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u> - For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

We Actively Choose To Stand On The Side Of The Spirit Over Against The Flesh.

<u>Psalm 40:8</u> - I take joy in doing your will, my God, for your instructions are written on my heart.
