<u>Philippians 3:20-21</u> - But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. <u>1 Corinthians 9:24-27</u> - Don't you realize that in a race everyone runs, but only one person gets the prize? So run to win! ²⁵ All athletes are disciplined in their training. They do it to win a prize that will fade away, but we do it for an eternal prize. ²⁶ So I run with purpose in every step. Living In Abundance Requires A Transformed Mind

1. God's Eternal Nature.

<u>Psalm 90:2</u> - Before the mountains were born, before you gave birth to the earth and the world, from beginning to end, you are God.

<u>Revelation 1:8</u> - "I am the Alpha and the Omega—the beginning and the end," says the Lord God. "I am the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come—the Almighty One."

2. Eternal Life.

<u>John 3:16</u> - For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

3. Eternal Truth.

Psalm 119:89 - Your eternal word, O LORD, stands firm in heaven.

4. Eternal Perspective.

<u>2 Corinthians 4:18</u> - So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, <u>we fix our gaze on things that</u> <u>cannot be seen</u>. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.

5. Eternal Judgment.

<u>Hebrews 9:27</u> - And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment
